Roof renovation with RHEINZINK GRANUM basalte

For the metal roof of a holiday home, the roofer used the new surface quality RHEINZINK GRANUM basalte for the first time. The carefully adapted roof layout and the precise roof division emphasise the noble appearance of the matt and deep dark material.

The holiday home of the Keuler family of roofers and plumbers was built in the early 1970s in the bungalow style and a roof covering typical of the time with the Berlin wave. Minor storm damage, defective gutters and the first leaks now required renewal. Besides, a roofer's house should look decent at all times, as Stefan Keuler emphasises. Of course, this also applies when, as in this case, there are about 450 km between the holiday home and the company's headquarters in Niederzissen, Rhineland-Palatinate.
